Subject:

Scope - Receptacles pi marked

Question:

Can receptacles (in the meaning of Article 2 of Transportable Pressure Equipment Directive) that are "pi" marked be used as static pressure equipment without being CE marked?

Answer:

Yes, provided the PI  $(\pi)$  marked receptacle has been placed on the market and used as transportable pressure equipment, it can then be used permanently as static pressure equipment without being CE marked.

Note 1: For static use the receptacle may be subject to national regulations dealing with conditions of use, installation and periodic inspection (see also Article 3 of TPED 2010/35/EU – On-site requirements).

Note 2: The term "static pressure equipment" has to be understood as "pressure equipment under the scope of Pressure Equipment Directive", even though these receptacles fall under Article 1 paragraph 2 (s) of PED.

Note 3: See PED Guideline A-30 (CLAP X034) for receptacles with double CE-mark and  $\pi$  mark.
