ESR on material - Fine grained steel

Question:

What does the exclusion of fine-grained steel in the first dash of section 7.1.2 of Annex I of the directive mean?

Annex I § 7.1.2

Answer:

Those fine grained steels are micro-alloyed steels for pressure purposes as, for example, those given in EN 10028-3 or in EN 10222-4.

For these steels, the quantitative value of permissible membrane stress stated in Annex I Section 7.1.2 does not apply. However an equivalent overall level of safety must be achieved (refer to Guideline H-06 (CLAP X168)).
