Subject:	Classification of ejectors
Question:	How are ejectors classified?
Answer:	Ejectors are static equipment in which the energy, provided by the expansion of an auxiliary pressurized fluid (called "driving fluid"), allows by Venturi effect: - to aspire, compress or mix fluids, - to vacuum or pressurized the enclosures, - to transport fluids, powders or sludge, - to transfer heat. Due to their operational function, ejectors meet the definition of a pressure accessory given in article 2 point 5 of PED (see CLAP X014 – PED Guideline A-08).
