Question:	If a vessel contains a fluid which meets the conditions of the introductory paragraph to Article 3 § 1.1(a) (e.g. air) and a liquid which meets the conditions of the introductory paragraph to Article 3 § 1.1(b) (e.g. water) - how shall the vessel be classified?							
Answer:	Article 9 § 3 states the classification shall be on the basis of the fluid which requires the higher category. The total volume (V) of the vessel, as defined in Article 1 § 2.5, shall be used to determine the conformity assessment category, not the actual volume occupied by the individual fluids at any particular time.
